Timeline and Overview

ANet will collaborate with five districts and CMOs over four years to show what's possible in instructional improvement when we put the right conditions in place, enable long-term partnership, and pair system coherence with integrated school support.

Districts in ANet's Breakthrough Results Fund cohort will learn from each other, benefit from philanthropy, and be a part of proving what's possible. We'll maximize our impact and build stories of what our work together over four years can accomplish in advancing educational equity.

Districts and CMOs who meet eligibility requirements are invited to submit an application due mid-March.

Five systems are selected as Breakthrough Results Fund partners by mid-Spring. System-level support is provided at no cost to the system.

Ten schools in each system are selected to receive ANet's full integrated support system with half the cost subsidized by philanthropy. (Additional schools may be added at standard price.)
